HARBOURFRONT STREETCAR TUNNEL DRAINAGE WORK

Rescheduled - Saturday, April 25, 2009

Queen's Quay Station

In a TTC notice dated February 2, 2009, the TTC advised that maintenance work to clear obstructions to a storm/sanitary pit located within the Harbourfront streetcar tunnel situated beneath Bay Street at Queen's Quay Station would be conducted. The work was not performed due to unforeseen circumstances. This work has now been rescheduled for **Saturday, April 25th between 1:30 a.m. and 6:00 a.m.**

METHOD OF WORK

A high-pressure vacuum system is required to clear the obstructions and debris. The system is mounted on a truck. The truck will be parked at street level in the southbound curb lane on Bay Street immediately south of Harbour Street near the sidewalk staircase entrance to TTC's Queen's Quay streetcar station. While the unit is equipped with noise suppressers, sound emission may be evident.

POINT OF ACCESS

A crew will access the station with a vacuum hose system via the vent shaft grating located on the west sidewalk on Bay Street north of Queen's Quay West.

WORK HOURS

To do this work and maintain the highest safety standards for TTC passengers and the contractor's workers, work can only be carried out during non-revenue hours.

The work will be carried out when the Harbourfront streetcar line is shut down during the early morning hours of Saturday, April 25, 2009. The shift will be scheduled from approximately 1:30 a.m. to 6:00 a.m. The crew will clean up and vacate the premise before the station opens for Saturday morning streetcar operations. If necessary, a second nightshift will be scheduled for the next available date in order to complete any remaining work.
