IMPORTANT NOTICE TO BICYCLE OWNERS.
SECOND PHASE OF BICYCLE REMOVAL

July 19, 2011

Dear Residents – 10 Yonge Street and 10 Queen's Quay West
We are ready for our second phase!

In order to keep track of all bicycles parked in the assigned bicycle spaces in the underground, it is essential to have a bicycle tag on your bicycle at all times. If you have lost your tag, we ask you to contact the management office to receive a new tag with the bicycle parking space number.

Residences of the World Trade Centre have only 200 bike parking spaces. We presently have a waiting list of 40 bicycles. If you are not registered to park your bicycle in a bicycle space, you will need to remove your bicycle.

All bicycles which are locked on spaces to which they have not been allocated or have no bicycle tags will have their locks cut and will be removed from the underground.

In addition, if you have a red, yellow, or orange tag, you will need to exchange your old tag for new tags by Tuesday, July 26, 2011. On Wednesday, July 27, all bicycles that do not have the NEW tags will be removed.

It will be your responsibility to arrange storage until waitlist is cleared. If you wish to be put on the waiting list, please contact the management office. Please be reminded that only one registered bicycle per spot. No sharing permitted.

Renewal of bicycle registration will be on an annual basis for the month of July.
